FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT

THIS EVENT IS NOT TIMED. ALL THE NORMAL RULES OF THE ROAD APPLY. THE ORGANISERS HAVE TRIED TO ENSURE ANY POTENTIAL STOPPING POINTS ARE SAFE HOWEVER THEY WILL INEVITABLY BE CLOSE TO PUBLIC ROADS SO CARE MUST BE TAKEN AND CONSIDERATION TO OTHER ROAD USERS GIVEN **AT ALL TIMES**.

The Treasure Hunt will start from **THE PHEONIX** pub on the A30 just to the West of **HARTLEY WINTNEY** between 1 and 2 pm. There is a petrol station next to this pub.

Gren and Katie will be there with starting packs. These packs will contain everything you need for the event. All directions are easy to follow (not cryptic). Questions are in the order that the answers appear on the route. Mileage will be taken at the start & end of the Treasure Hunt as the lowest mileage will win in the event of a tie.

The overall distance will be around 30 miles to maintain the expected duration of between two and three hours.

All answers can be obtained in places open to access by the public. You will not need to trespass.

There are **NEUTRAL SECTIONS** identified on the directions for this Treasure Hunt. These are sections of road where there are no clues. Typically they are major roads or twisty minor roads where slow progress, stopping or reversing would be dangerous. In these areas maintain steady progress until the directions indicate the neutral has finished. Be aware that fellow competitors may be coming the other way at any time during the event!

EQUIPMENT

Although everything you need will be in the starter pack it may be worth bringing the following:

- Clip board to support the answer sheet
- Colouring pencils, pens or crayons (different colours may prove useful!)
- Paper (so different team members can write down answers, try anagrams!, etc)
- Mobile Phone

HINTS

It **WILL** be important to read the instructions given before starting the event.

The answer that can be found on the route is the correct answer. For example if you are asked ‘What happened in 1969?’ the answer ‘Neil Armstrong became the first man to walk on the moon’, though technically correct, will not be worth any points if this is not information available on the route. Even if the information is technically wrong or out of date it is the answer on the route that is deemed correct.

Phonetics will be used so it is worth saying what you see. For example a Hair Dresser may be the answer to ‘Kitchen furniture for long eared rabbit’!

Most Important Rule: **ENJOY YOURSELVES**
